Ephesians 2:8-9	⁸ For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— ⁹ not by works, so that no one can boast.
Matthew 7:13-14	¹³ “Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. ¹⁴ But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.
Matthew 7:21-23	²¹ “Not everyone who says to me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. ²² Many will say to me on that day, ‘Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name and in your name drive out demons and in your name perform many miracles?’ ²³ Then I will tell them plainly, ‘I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!’
Mark 14:61-65	Again the high priest asked him, “Are you the Messiah, the Son of the Blessed One?” ⁶² “I am,” said Jesus. “And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven.” ⁶³ The high priest tore his clothes. “Why do we need any more witnesses?” he asked. ⁶⁴ “You have heard the blasphemy. What do you think?” They all condemned him as worthy of death. ⁶⁵ Then some began to spit at him; they blindfolded him, struck him with their fists, and said, “Prophecy!” And the guards took him and beat him.
Luke 11:27-28	²⁷ As Jesus was saying these things, a woman in the crowd called out, “Blessed is the mother who gave you birth and nursed you.” ²⁸ He replied, “Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it.”

John 8:24	<p>²⁴ I told you that you would die in your sins; if you do not believe that I am he, you will indeed die in your sins.”</p>
John 11:25-26	<p>²⁵ Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; ²⁶ and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?”</p>
John 14:6	<p>⁶ Jesus answered, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.</p>
1 Corinthians 6: 9-10	<p>Do not be deceived: Neither the sexually immoral nor idolaters nor adulterers nor men who have sex with men^[a] ¹⁰ nor thieves nor the greedy nor drunkards nor slanderers nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God.</p>
2 Corinthians 5:10	<p>¹⁰ For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each of us may receive what is due us for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad.</p>
Galatians 3:24	<p>²⁴ So the law was our guardian until Christ came that we might be justified by faith.</p>
Galatians 5:4	<p>⁴ You who are trying to be justified by the law have been alienated from Christ; you have fallen away from grace.</p>
James 2:10	<p>¹⁰ For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles at just one point is guilty of breaking all of it.</p>
1 John 5:12-13	<p>¹² Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.</p> <p>¹³ I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.</p>
Revelation 21:8	<p>⁸ But the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars—they will be</p>

	consigned to the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death.”
1 John 2:19	¹⁹ They went out from us, but they did not really belong to us. For if they had belonged to us, they would have remained with us; but their going showed that none of them belonged to us.
1 John 1:1-3	¹ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was with God in the beginning. ³ Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.
Acts 20:24	²⁴ However, I consider my life worth nothing to me; my only aim is to finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me—the task of testifying to the good news of God’s grace.
Isaiah 53:3-6	<p>³ He was despised and rejected by mankind, a man of suffering, and familiar with pain. Like one from whom people hide their faces he was despised, and we held him in low esteem.</p> <p>⁴ Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted.</p> <p>⁵ But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.</p> <p>⁶ We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.</p>
